people have acted and in a sense immediately although not directly they have imposed the specific tax in question by permitting it to be imposed by their delegate to the Legislature.

MR. CASE: That is the same point Franklin
Burdette was making. I think it has no validity, that the
tax has to be imposed by the elected representatives of
the people, not by some department or agency selected
by the representatives of the people.

MR. SYKES: Wouldn't it be clear if the word, directly, or some such thing that would negate delegation, were written into the Article?

MR. CASE: If you can think of a word that is perfectly acceptable to me because this is the whole idea to negate delegation to anyone other than an elected representative of the group.

MR. SYKES: I would suggest the word, except directly by the elected representatives of the people --

you on that? The County Commissioners are going to have the power to impose taxes and while they are Legislative,
