privilege or service or anything of that sort. 1 2 Mr. Gentry? MR. GENTRY: I recognize your substitution of 3 an existing Article in the Declaration, but does the 4 Committee feel strongly that it should go in with the 5 Declaration which heretofore or up to this point has been 6 a reservation of private rights whereas this is, I would 7 look at this as more of a restriction on the plenary 8 taxing powers of the State. 9 MR. CASE: The answer to that is that our 10 Committee has no desire to encroach upon the territory 11 so well developed by your Committee, and we will be 12 very happy to construct our own little Article which we 13 will call Revenue and Finances, and put this in that. 14 Very good. MR. GENTRY: 15 MRS. BOTHE: There will be one anyway, won't 16 17 there? I think so. 18 MR. CASE: I think that is where it belongs MR. GENTRY: 19 20 and not a Declaration. Mr. Sykes, can we come back to 21 THE CHAIRMAN:
