differentiate between the State level and local level. 1 MR. SYKES: The only thing that gives me some 2 concern is your example or somebody's example of school 3 boards who have a certain amount, may have a certain 4 amount of legislative power. But I would be perfectly 5 happy with your formulation of it if that problem doesn't 6 give you any trouble. 7 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, this is normally the kind 8 of thing I would like to refer back to the Committee, but 9 time is such I don't know whether it is feasible. Can .10 we ask the Committee and its Chairman to think about this 11 and maybe come back to it before this meeting is over 12 rather than adopt the language right here. 13 MR. CASE: I will think about it. 14 THE CHAIRMAN: Is that satisfactory? 15 MR. SYKES: Yes, sir. 16 MR. CASE: I think it is all right the way it 17 is. You clutter it up with a lot of words, and you just 18 19 get nowhere. THE CHAIRMAN: The next recommendation. 20 MR. CASE: Now, we move on to Article 15 and 21
