Article 43 which have to be considered together and the Report, I know probably a lot of you have not had a chance to read the background of 15, which is a very interesting background to those of us who enjoy thinking about fiscal matters. It goes back all the way as far as our Constitution is concerned, although it has been amended primarily, well, in a major instance in 1915 an amendment was made to validate a city tax on securities that had been invalidly collected for about twenty years prior to that and also an amendment which was embraced with great fervor by the single tax movement indicating how a movement such as this can come under the tent of people who have good (intentions and still something in a basic document such as a Constitution which lasts for many years and people forget what is behind it, and then they don't really know what it means in the first place. So, there is an interesting historical background, and I would invite the Commission to look at the Report, because I think it gives a fairly good synopsis, thanks to Mr. Sachs, of this background. Now, I am not going to go into it all except as it applies to the specific points that
