think, every Member of the Committee feels this is a sound thing to do, that is to say, to classify land devoted to farm or agricultural use differently from other lands; and secondly, there was passed, as you all will recall, at one of the earlier sessions of this Commission, a general guideline rule whichsaid to the effect that where a matter has been presented to the people in the very recent past, where the matter has been discussed with some degree of clarity, hopefully some degree, that these decisions made by the people should not be summarily rejected by this Commission.

If there is ever a situation which would admit the application of this rule, it is this situation where you have the Court of Appeals throwing the whole program out and the Legislature coming right behind it and reinstating the program, a great deal of conversation having been had in the newspaper and other news dissemination media and the people accepting the idea by a better than 3 to 1 vote. It is for this reason that you will find at the end of Article 15 a particular mention of property devoted to agricultural use.
