3 to have it.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe?

5 MRS. BOTHE: On this agricultural use inclu-
6 sion, is that being put in there only to show our respect
7 to the present Constitution, or in other words, could
8 agricultural land be classified as such without this
9 language being in it?

10 MR. CASE: Under the draft, it could be.

11 MRS. BOTHE: In other words, the purpose is
12 simply to quiet the fears of those who don't believe it?

13 MR. CASE: Correct. It is certainly a purpose.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions?

15 Mr. Clagett?

16 MR. CLAGETT: However, this language does
17 not apply to the active use to which the land is being
18 devoted, and it actually does permit ownership being the
19 criteria rather than the actual use of the land?

20 MR. CASE: If the Legislature sets it aside.

21 MR. CLAGETT: That is not so good.
