

1 classification of agricultural land. I think if we  
2 make it clear in our work book and records that our in-  
3 tentation was not to be, repeal Article 43 in reference  
4 to agricultural differentiation, that this would suffice,  
5 and that we need not clutter up the Constitution with  
6 it. Besides, I think, long before the Constitution wears  
7 out that this whole question of extra taxation for sub-  
8 divisions is going to be inaccurate. It isn't like  
9 paupers, taxed, and I hate to see something of this kind  
10 go into a streamlined Constitution. For that reason,  
11 I will move the last phrase be deleted.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: I will put your motion down,  
13 but I did not mean to suggest that the phrase doesn't  
14 add anything. I think as to agricultural use, there is.
