1 agree that the power to subclassify as stated in the 2 first part would be sufficiently broad to take care of 3 that. 4 THE CHAIRMAN: Would it hurt your last clause if you said, agricultural or other open land use? 5 6 MR. CLAGETT: I was going to say, Mr. Chair-7 man, or open space use. MR. CASE: I think it would do the trick if 8 9 the Commission would like it. 10 THE CHAIRMAN: I think there ought to be some 11 discussion of this point. 12 Mr. Clagett? 13 MR. CLAGETT: I make a motion that the words, or 14 open space, be added at the end of that sentence. 15 DR. BARD: To agricultural use, or open space 16 use. 17 THE CHAIRMAN: We could say agricultural or 18 open space. MR. CLAGETT: That reads better. 19 20 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second?

DR. BARD: I second it.

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
