6 is one that is highly important in the 1960's and in a
7 sense, it would reflect some of our concerns which are
8 so very vivid in this area, particularly in regard to
9 planning, et cetera, and I think that it would move us
10 to more modern view if we did include it.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

12 MR. SCANLAN: As we recall the law of zoning,
13 similar in the field of taxation, the open space concept
14 is a novel one and possibly the permissive, may, the
15 Court would say it may include, and on the other hand,
16 it may not include, open space land. I hadn't thought
17 about it before I came here this morning, and I think
18 the additional phrase would be helpful.
