1 more than the present language. THE CHAIRMAN: Let's have your suggestion 2 3 again. 4 MR. SYKES: And such classification may be based upon the agricultural or open space use of property. 5 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second? 6 DR. BURDETTE: Would that include the subclassi-7 8 fication? MR. SYKES: Such classification would include 9 10 then classes and subclasses. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: You second, Dr. Burdette? 12 DR. BURDETTE: I second. 13 THE CHAIRMAN: Give us the language again. 14 And such classification --MR. SYKES: -- may be based upon agricultural 15 16 or open space use of property. 17 THE CHAIRMAN: Any comment, Mr. Case? MR. CASE: No, I think the Committee has 18 19 worked hard on this language, and thinks it ought to be 20 the way it is written here, and I will let it go to a 21 vote.
