3 MR. BOND: I would like to point out for the
4 record that agricultural and open space usages are not
5 in the alternative, and the word, or, leads to redundancy
6 and vagueness. You can have open space use and agricul-
7 tural use on the same piece of land.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: It seems to me if you use the
9 word, and, then you would have more trouble.

10 MR. CASE: I think his statement for the rec-
11 ord is all you need.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment with res-
13 pect to this Section? I would like to make just two
14 observations so that the record will be abundantly clear.
15 In the use, in this Section of the phrase, any tax imposed
16 in this State, I take it, Mr. Case, that the Committee
17 is recommending that this provision of the Constitution
18 be applicable to taxes imposed at every level of govern-
19 ment.
