THE CHAIRMAN: Secondly, you commented in answer to somebody's question with respect to an exemption that it is possible today if it be permitted by the Legislature. Now, if the Commission approves the tentative Report of the Committee on Political Subdivisions, the County and other local subdivisions will have full taxing powers except as withdrawn, so that this would permit Counties, and if they in turn permit municipalities, permit municipalities to grant special exemptions such as manufacturers' exemptions or industrial exemptions of various kinds. I take it your answer to the earlier question is still the same, that the Counties' right to do that, notwithstanding the broad grant of power under the Constitution to local subdivisions will be subject to the limitation of this Section, that it must be a reasonable classification for all such exemptions.
