

1 DR. BURDETTE: No.

2 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Burdette, do you want to  
3 be recorded as No?

4 DR. BURDETTE: Yes.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Anyone else want to have their  
6 vote recorded by name?

7 JUDGE WALSH: I want to have mine recorded  
8 as being opposed. I don't know what the motion was. I  
9 am voting against the authority to give the Legislature  
10 the authority.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Then your vote will be against  
12 the authority. Any further discussion? Move on to the  
13 next one.

14 MR. CASE: The next two things are really --  
15 I think can be handled quite shortly or quite briefly.
