THE CHAIRMAN: May we resume the session now?

In accordance with the announcement before lunch, we will now take up as a special order of business the further Report of the Committee on Miscellaneous Provisions.

Mrs. Bothe?

MRS. BOTHE: As the Chairman stated before the lunch recess, the Committee on Miscellaneous Provisions has unanimously determined to ask that this group reconsider the motion rejected by an 11 to 10 vote at the last meeting of the Commission. I believe that the attendance at today's Commission meeting is larger than it was at that time, and in view of the very close vote, it was the Committee's feeling that the matter should be reconsidered by the Commission.

We have followed the Commission's directive and proposed some possible language as has also Mr. Eney. Those of you who took the time during the lunch recess to look at these provisions I think can see why we have brought our original one back for your consideration.
