Commission don't have it with them. It was as follows:

The University of Maryland shall be managed by the Regents of the University of Maryland in accordance with law and the Regents shall have exclusive general supervision of the institution, and the control and direction of all expenditures from the institution's funds.

This Section would have given the constitutional security to the University of Maryland which it now enjoys by statute. In view of the long debate, and I don't even know if I would be proper on our motion to reconsider to emphasize anything further than the very close vote that was taken before, I would ask everyone here whichever way they voted before and whichever way they attempt to vote again, to at least let the matter be reconsidered at this time, and I so move, Mr. Chairman.

THE CHAIRMAN: Before we have the motion, let's have these provisions that anybody may want, questions about the motion.
