THE CHAIRMAN: The motion will be decided without debate, but because of that, do we have any questions as to these provisions?

Mr. Scanlan?

MR. SCANLAN: Although I didn't find the Committee's reasons when they came in, in support of the proposed Section 3, I still would like to see, to hear their reasons why they reject the three suggestions contained in this Special Report. I might find their negative reasons more compelling than their affirmative reasons.

MRS. EOTHE: Of course, Mr. Eney's suggestion did not come to us until today, and it is to be noted our directive at the last meeting was, as I understood it, merely to make proposals which granted some lesser degree of autonomy to the University, and there was nothing said at that time with regard to other institutions of higher learning as Mr. Eney includes in his proposal. So the Committee has no comment to make one way or the other in that respect. However, as regards the propositions
