States. We stuck it in for that reason. It could perhaps be read to be equivalent to our proposed Section 3, but it has never been so construed.

The other two merely exhort the Legislature to do what they have done in the case of the University, but do not mandate it. Therefore, we see no purpose served by including them, and of course, it is exactly the opposite to our intended purpose in the language of the suggested Section 3 which was, of course, debated at some length at the last meeting. I think everyone on the Commission understands the difference between constitutional degree of autonomy.
