Report to recognition of other institutions other than the 1 University of Maryland would not apply to the proposal 2 before the Commission now. Our reasons as expressed 3 there involve the state of development of the other 4 higher educational institutions that could not very well 5 be stratified in the Constitution in this present form. 6 However, the exhortatory language which Dr. Bard proposes 7 or rather the directive to the Legislature is one which 8 and I believe also the Committee, feel would leave 9 the latitude for development of the other institutions 10 of higher learning which we think is desirable, we feel 11 that in the long term they should be granted as much, 12 I hate to use the word, autonomy, but they should be 13 granted as much independence as his consistent with their 14 ability to operate independently. 15 MR. BOND: I wonder if we could have the 16 language as proposed by Dr. Bard read again? 17 THE CHAIRMAN: The language is to add to Sec-18 tion 3 the following: In the State colleges and other 19 public institutions of higher education shall formulate 20 policies for their respective institutions and shall, 21 by lew, be grented songh, additions hangwers of supervision,
