

1 heads on a Siamese twin or Siamese twins that would
2 pull the body in different directions, with no place in
3 the State to coordinate the policies insofar as they
4 conflict.

5 MR. CASE: Can I answer that?

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case?

7 MR. CASE: I would like to make a statement
8 in favor of this motion and in so doing, I will answer
9 Mr. Sykes' question.

10 Since the advent of the Curlett Commission's
11 Report three years ago, higher education in this State
12 has for the first time taken on a unified direction.
13 Under that Report as ultimately adopted and then as sup-
14 plemented by legislative amendment, there is a council,
15 an advisory council on higher education which theoretically
16 sits at the apex of the triangle dealing with these
17 subjects in our State. The University of Maryland is
18 one of the three parts of higher education. The State
19 colleges are a second part, and the junior colleges are
20 the third part.
