3 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, sir.

4 MR. MILLER: What will be the program?

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Be open to further amendment.

6 Mr. Della?

7 MR. DELLA: Mr. Chairman, in the discussion
8 of the colleges, what position does this leave the com-
9 munity colleges? Are they still on the outside?

10 THE CHAIRMAN: As Dr. Bard explained, they
11 are not State institutions. They are institutions of
12 the local subdivision of Baltimore City, and so forth.
13 They would not be covered by this proposal.

14 Any further debate? Any further discussion?

15 I would like to state my own position on this
16 amendment, because as is obvious, a greater part of it is
17 the language taken from the amendment which I had sug-
18 gested for the consideration of the Commission before
19 lunch. I am going to vote for the motion, but I do so
20 with a great deal of reluctance because I share the con-
21 cern expressed by Mr. Martineau, and, on one part, and
