

1 THE CHAIRMAN: That is exactly why I expressed
2 concern, because Mr. Miller had asked if the Section was
3 open to further amendment, and I said it was. This
4 motion goes to the complete substitution of a different
5 provision for the motion, for the provisions that have
6 been adopted. I very frankly am uncertain and --

7 MR. MILLER: I might say, Mr. Chairman, I am
8 uncertain, too, as to the parliamentary. But it seems
9 to me when the Chair has given me a ruling that was
10 with this very thing in mind I asked if it would be open
11 to change and was told Yes, and there was not a voice raised
12 in opposition. It would seem to me that irrespective of
13 what might be the irregular rule on this, that it would
14 at least be operating as a distinct reversal as far as
15 what the Chair told me.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case?

17 MR. CASE: Mr. Chairman, I think the time has
18 come as far as this University of Maryland thing is
19 concerned, to stop playing games. Thirteen people on
20 this Commission have voted for the limited degree of
21 autonomy for the University as suggested in Number 3 of
