4 THE CHAIRMAN: You ready for the question?
5 The vote Aye sustains the Chair and sustains the motion.
6 A vote Nay rules the motion out of order. All those
7 voting Aye, signify by a show of hands. Contrary?
8 The Chair's ruling is sustained, 14 to 7; the motion
9 therefore is in order. The motion, as I understand it,
10 and you will have to correct me if I don't have it right,
11 Mr. Scanlan, is as follows:

12 The governing boards provided by law for State
13 institutions of higher learning --

14 MR. SCANLAN: Higher education.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: -- shall formulate policies
16 for their respective institutions and shall have general
17 supervision thereof in all academic matters. They shall
18 by law be granted such additional powers of supervision,
19 direction and control of their respective institutions
20 and the expenditure of the funds thereof as may be fea-
21 sible and consistent with their status as public agencies,
