

1 However, it is the judgment the representatives
2 of the people will make, and a judgment that only the
3 representatives of the people should make. It should
4 not be a judgment frozen into the Constitution.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

6 Mr. Bond?

7 MR. BOND: Just a point of order. I understand
8 the Chair will allow Judge Adkins and Mr. Smith to be
9 paired off against each other.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: I have no such authority.
11 Under the previous Sections of this assembly, I understood
12 Judge Adkins' decision would be that he would not vote,
13 and therefore failure to count his vote and Mr. Smith's
14 would, in effect, be a pair.

15 Mrs. Bothe?

16 MRS. BOTHE: If Mr. Case wants to go ahead
