

1 respective institutions and expenditures of the funds
2 thereof as may be feasible and consistent with their
3 status as public agencies.

4 Now, Mr. Bond, you had a point of order.

5 MR. BOND: I will withdraw it.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre?

7 MR. SAYRE: Wait, this is beautiful, the way
8 the language has been worked out. My problem on the
9 original language, number one, was that I didn't want to
10 discriminate against the other schools compared with
11 Maryland. I didn't see how we could favor Maryland with
12 that kind of autonomy that didn't have, by law, in it.
13 The other problem was, I felt if I gave them exclusive
14 provision for the University of Maryland, per se, pre-
15 vented another similar body, for instance, right now the
16 University of Maryland is the University of California of
17 Maryland. What if we had a U.C.L.A.? What about another
18 board? What about all these various complications that
19 come with growth, say within twenty years, and not just
20 1980? The contradiction that I felt in there has now been
21 removed, and if we are going to have a provision in the
