phrase, in accordance with law, suggests that the General 1 Assembly of Maryland has significant and perhaps the 2 same powers they now have over the University. Our pro-3 vision, as we have provided in the pending motion, at least 4 has the advantage of clarity, and as Mr. Sykes says, 5 defining the relationship of the General Assembly and 6 defining that relationship in accordance, in relation 7 to the governing bodies of the various institutions. 8 THE CHAIRMAN: All right.
