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THE CHAIRMAN: It seems to me that we don't need to repeat the entire debate. It is clear that under the motion made by Mr. Scanlan, the University of Maryland would not have the constitutional autonomy that was provided for by Section 3, and I think he has stated that that is his intention. Now, ready for the question?

Let me make this statement before I take the vote. I don't think it need be said. I think we would all understand that the Section as redrafted is more in accordance with my views then either the original draft of Section 3 or the draft of Section 3 as amended. Nevertheless, because of the fact that Mr. Smith was here this morning and is not here now, that the vote was so close and notwithstanding the fact that Judge Adkins abstained from voting, I don't think that goes to the whole question, the Chair will abstain from voting on this question also.

All those in favor, please signify by a show of hands. Contrary? The motion fails, 10 to 11. Any further amendments? Any further discussion of Section 3?
