opportunity for more consideration and deliberation of legislative matters. However, I don't see where that would be in any way diminished by reason of there being but one House.

On the other hand, I feel that there is a possibility where there are two Houses to pass the buck, to have one House as we have seen many times in the past with a great to-do, one House will pass a bill, knowing all the time that it is going to be killed in the other House across the hall. I don't think that system would prevail in a unicameral, under a unicameral system, and I think the unicameral system lends itself to more responsible and more responsive method of legislating the problems before the State.

For this reason, I would say that there be no justification for the two Houses, because geographical representation is no longer permissible, I would urge our State switch over to a unicemeral system.
