3 it. I think up until now, all we have done so far as the
4 Constitution is concerned in many respects, is to dress
5 it up. I think when it goes before the public, a lot
6 of the people will not understand, and they won't care
7 too much about many of the refinements that we are trying
8 to make insofar as the Constitution is concerned; but
9 I think if we present this question to them, as I think
10 it is the most significant reform we have come up with
11 yet, it is basic, and I think if it is explained to them,
12 it will generate interest; and I think in talking to
13 Mel Sykes, I think we both thought this was a forward-
14 looking thing, and I think you will get the people to
15 understand it, and they are ready for it. There is no
16 question in my mind that the unicameral Legislature will
17 be far more economical than the bicameral. Many of the
18 students of government offer many arguments in favor of
19 unicameral Legislature. I think most of the articles
20 that have been written are in favor of it. Perhaps that
21 is due to the fact that this is a change, whereas those
