

1 unicameralism than we might suspect, and I think this is
2 a time when we should vote our convictions. This is
3 merely a recommendation, and we should vote what is
4 appropriate.

5 I might say in connection with that, I think
6 that if we, if the Constitutional Convention adopts
7 a bicameral Legislature, I think we will have that for
8 the next one hundred years. It is not a question of
9 giving the reapportionment bicameral Legislature a time
10 to see if it works, and if it doesn't work, we can
11 change to a unicameral. If we adopt it now, we will
12 always have it. If we adopt the unicameral Legislature
13 now, and it doesn't work out, it would not be very
14 difficult to change back to a bicameral Legislature.

15 Another point, it seems to me that those who
16 argue that the small Counties should favor a bicameral
17 Legislature because they will have greater protection
18 there, I think are making a great mistake. Take, for
19 example, my own County of Carroll, we are a smaller
20 County included in a district of a number of other Coun-
21 ties and do not have the population to elect that senator.
