I think for all practical purposes in the smaller body of the General Assembly those Counties are going to be unrepresented, and I think this is one, to me, one of the great dangers of having a Senate which will have to be represented/multi-County districts; and I would much prefer to have just one House in which the representation can be on as low a basis as possible; and just my last point, which is just completely opposite of what Judge Adkins has said, I think that with the fact of reapportionment, those people who want to have a bicameral Legislature, it seems to me, have the burden of proof here, and I really have tried very hard in all the debate that has been going on, involving bicameral and unicameral Legislatures, to find out some reason which would justify the keeping of a bicameral Legislature; and I certainly have not heard any arguments which have any, carry any weight as far as I am concerned with the keeping of a separate House of the General Assembly with all the problems and all the expense that goes ¿!ong with it.

So for that reason, I am going to vote in
