

1 on the Federal level but in the whole thumping majority
2 of the State, the system we have had is a good system.
3 It is the best ever devised and one of the fairest and
4 can show a lot to be said about the unicameral system,
5 it isn't proven as is the present system of two chambers.

6 One thing I think that people, if we had
7 just one body with forty or fifty members representing
8 the whole State, if there is a best quality, it wouldn't
9 ruin anything to have it done that way, but those men
10 would have a tremendous burden with only forty or fifty
11 legislators for the whole State, it would practically
12 and particularly as we were talking of limited sessions,
13 it would practically mean that everybody had to serve
14 on several committees, and the result would be that the
15 committee activity would be greatly hampered, in my opinion.

16 One other point that I think is very impor-
17 tant, and it certainly has been true, both on the State
18 and on the Federal level, is that the legislative body
19 gets a great deal of benefit from just the man on the
20 street, the fellow that comes in and says, What are you
21 going to do about this, or, You ought to do that. Well,
