versus unicemeral. If we don't really have that much
reservation amongst those who do for the unicemeral,
it would make it so that you would havebetween now and
the time of the Convention for people to be talking about
this.

Now, I am just sure from the appointments I have that the people don't care one way or the other. If we do reduce cost, they would be in favor of that. If we could increase the quality of our Legislature, they would be in favor of that. If we could elevate the stature of our Legislature, they would be in favor of I know of no other way than to elevate the stature of the Legislature than to have them actually represent more people, as for example, the Council of Los Angeles represents where you would rather be a councilman than a legislator. I would name our Legislature to the Senate. I would do the same thing as we have done in the District Court, make it stand out where they have greater responsibility and as a result of this greater responsibility. we are going to get people who will be more inclined to serve in the Legislature who before would much rather
