reason for bicameralism had disappeared. The only reason 1 that remains that I can see is the argument of check 2 and balance, that one House reconsiders what the other 3 House has done, and thus we get safety in our legislation. 4 I have been studying this matter of legislation longer 5 than anyone else in this room, chiefly for the reason 6 I have had more time to do it. But starting at least in 7 1927, which is at least thirty-nine years ago, I put a 8 great deal of attention to the question of State Legis-9 That qualifies me, perhaps, for an opinion. 10 latures. I watched this business of checks and balances 11 with considerable care. I sat in a committee of a State 12 Legislature some years ago where bills from the other 13 In 45 minutes that committee House were being considered. 14 disposed of 17 laws which they/never laid eyes on before 15 which they had no time to read, which they didn't even 16 give the substance of, and if you know as I suppose you 17 do, that the Houses of State Legislatures almost without 18 exception follow the instructions of their, the recom-19

mendations of their committees, this is not, I would say,
