of the time schedule when bills are introduced in each 1 House and then pass over from one House to the other, you 2 discover that the number of bills going to the second 3 House in the last ten days of the session, and this is 4 true in Maryland as it is true elsewhere, the number of 5 bills going to the second House in the last ten days of 6 the session are so large that there is not possibly time 7 for careful reconsideration, and very few of them get 8 careful reconsideration to the point that over and over 9 again, and I can name cases where bills have been passed 10 by one llouse without regard for the feelings of the 11 author on the basis that the other House would catch 12 them, and the other House hasn't caught them because they 13 say, This bill has been carefully considered in the first 14 It seems to me that this Commission would do well 15 to adopt the unicameral idea. 16 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Michener? 17 DR.
