2 lation of a State nature, excluding that of a local
3 nature. So, if we were to follow under the proposal of
4 the Committee on Local Government, Political Subdivisions,
5 a home rule procedure eliminating from the Legislature
6 the responsibility for local legislation and the State
7 were just to consider State matters, if experience is
8 any teacher, then the second review amounts to about 7
9 per cent of that legislation and weighed against the
10 price of that as compared to possible advantage of a
11 unicameral legislation where each member is a more impor-
12 tant legislator than he is in a bicameral system, since
13 the spotlight of responsibility is directly upon the pro-
14 ponents of each measure, since the proponent who intro-
15 duces it and carries through a bill will pretty well be
16 the determinant of the success or failure of the measure
17 rather than relying on another House to take care of the
18 measure which may be ill-conceived to begin with, each
19 legislator would be given a great deal more service,
20 secretarial and research as well as given an increase
21 in salary.
