maybe more expensive to give up what I think we have had 1 for such a long time, that is not a good reason. I know 2 that, but you don't run with both feet at the same time, 3 and my hesitation is to keep what we've got. I am in 4 favor of having the presentation for any statement at 5 all that can be made of the virtues of a unicameral 6 system. My feeling is that the degree of its importance 7 and on the assumption that I am wrong in my thinking, 8 I think it ought to be presented to the Convention so 9 that they can make up their minds. I am just in a posi-10 tion where I don't like to give up the thing that I, 11 at times, had to live with and which I got so much help. 12 I would like to state my views 13 THE CHAIRMAN: before we take a vole.
