if you have had an opportunity to read the paper dealing with some of the reasons why the unicameral system has worked successfully in Nebraska, which we passed out, you will note there is time for the public to become acquainted with what is taking place, that the way the hearings are structured, and if you follow the history of the bill, you see that there are gaps within the structure so that the public could become aware of occurrences.

There is another reason which I think has

application to Maryland, that is the dramatic change which George Norris brought to Nebraska created a new lever for interest on the part of the public as a whole. Almost overnight the people of Nebraska were excited about new opportunities which they had because there was a new structure. It may be true that inherently the differences were not sharp, but nevertheless it is important once in a while to move to a new structure when we think that it is significant. At our own hearings you will remember those in attendance, that many of the State senators in Maryland including the President of the State Senate
