indicated that they favored unicameralism because they felt that it would save a good deal of time and that ultimately, actually this matter being at cross purposes, was not true.

Yet another reason I would like to mention is the fact that our balance would become overcrowded, and not only is this bad within the symbol itself -- I know in some of our districts we have as many as eighty items on which to vote in the primary, in the last primary -- not only is this indicative of the symbol of the primary, but indicative of the fact that there are so many people that one needs to relate if he lives in a particular legislative district. This is especially in a city like Baltimore, that there are complexities in this situation, and to have a smaller number of representatives is indeed good.

Now, I think, too, the mere fact that the model State Constitution which has been put together by people who have made years of study on this question, and here the recommendation was strongly in favor of unicemeralism, I would like to indicate now one reason that
