

1 THE CHAIRMAN: And I assume you made no  
2 changes in the draft except such as were absolutely  
3 necessary to fit into the scheme of unicameral Legisla-  
4 ture?

5 DR. MICHENER: That is right, based on the  
6 Seventh Report as acted on by the Commission. The only  
7 thing where the two Houses are referred to as the General  
8 Assembly and where it has a substantive change was pri-  
9 marily on impeachment. It is where you don't have a  
10 senate to try impeachment, it says, Once the Assembly  
11 brings impeachment proceedings, and impeaches the officer,  
12 trial will be as provided by law. Otherwise, it follows.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Were there any other than that,  
14 were there any others where the changes necessary were  
15 merely word changes, where they involved any kind of  
16 change of substance?

17 DR. MICHENER: That is the only one of some  
18 substance.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Burdette?
