ment in that case the same way as we will in the basic recommendation on bicameralism.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Miller?

MR. MILLER: Have we ever decided whether these things are going to be three-fifths or two-thirds?

THE CHAIRMAN: That is on the agenda for this session. There is a memo, and we have picked out the instances in which there is one or the other. We hope to decide that before this meeting is over, but not this afternoon.

Any further discussion on unicameralism?

Any question about the draft of the Legislative Article based on unicameral Legislature? Well then, that, I think concludes that special order of business.

The next special order of business is the Sixth Report of the Committee on Political Subdivisions. In connection with that draft, there is another memo; there are two other memoranda, one called a staff memo, and the other called a proposed draft. Let me say a word as to the proposed draft, so it can be identified. This represents my efforts, so if you put the initials H.V.E.
