10 order? We now consider the third item of special busi-
11 ness, the Sixth Report of the Committee on Political
12 Subdivisions and Local Legislation.

13 Mr. Clagett?

14 MR. CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, I cannot but men-
15 tion at the outset the predominant sentiment of myself
16 and the Committee as one, and that is, we never thought
17 this day would come, and here it is. So here we go.

18 You will recall that back on September 20 we
19 began the consideration of what was then called a pre-
20 liminary draft not for publication of a Fifth Report, and
21 we had gone through the section there consisting of
