I don't think the question depends necessarily on the structure of the executive branch but on the responsiveness to the people when they are confronted with a situation like that.

JUDGE ADKINS: The real check of totalitarianism is the interplay between the Legislature and the Chief Executive and so long as policies, major policies, particularly the raising of taxes need to be implemented by the Legislature, it seems to me there you have your best check against abuse of power.

DR. BURDETTE: I should like to say for the a record that I do not consider that Alabama has/totalitarian form of Government. Perhaps this is extraneous.

MR. SCANLAN: I merely said that some did. ...
THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Gentry.
