

1 the area proposed to be transferred from one County to
2 another. The lines of more than three contiguous Coun-
3 ties, but less than all the Counties, shall not be
4 changed without the consent of a majority of the voters
5 of the State voting thereon.

6 Now, the significant changes here are that
7 we have captioned the Section, Units of Local Government,
8 rather than Organization of Local Government, and we
9 have in Subsection (a) retained the concept of Baltimore
10 City being treated as a County, thus making 24 Counties
11 throughout the State; and we have given definition to
12 municipal corporations as a phrase. We have there defined
13 it to mean a city, town or village but shall not include
14 Baltimore City or any County.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions?

16 JUDGE ADKINS: I think the word, incorporated,
17 ought to precede the words, city, town or village. It
18 doesn't mean what it says. It doesn't mean a village.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Clagett?

20 MR. CLAGETT: Let me see, Judge. I don't
21 think I understand your point.
