

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe?

2 MRS. BOTHE: Did the Committee consider whether  
3 it might not be advisable also to permit those in the  
4 County to which another County or part of a County would  
5 be annexed to participate in a decision as to whether  
6 this should occur? I am referring now to the provision  
7 that the majority of the voters to reside within the  
8 area proposed to be transferred shall have to agree to  
9 the transfer. What about those to whom they are being  
10 attached?

11 MR. CLACETT: Yes, that was considered, and  
12 this does represent a compromise insofar as the thinking  
13 of the Committee is concerned and was the choice made  
14 by the Committee.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sykes?

16 MR. SYKES: Do you or do you not require the  
17 concept of the majorities of the voters of the State  
18 voting thereon within each County?

19 THE CHAIRMAN: The general referendum pro-  
20 vision is what he is referring to there. No referendum  
21 required under this Section.
