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THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe?

MRS. BOTHE: Did the Committee consider whether it might not be advisible also to permit those in the County to which another County or part of a County would be annexed to participate in a decision as to whether this should occur? I am referring now to the provision that the majority of the voters to reside within the area proposed to be transferred shall have to agree to the transfer. What about those to whom they are being attached?

MR, CLACETT: Yes, that was considered, and this does represent a compromise insofar as the thinking of the Committee is concerned and was the choice made by the Committee.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sykes?

MR. SYKES: Do you or do you not require the concept of the majorities of the voters of the State voting thereon within each County?

THE CHAIRMAN: The general referendum provision is what he is referring to there. No referendum required under this Section.
