

1 MR. CLAGETT: I think the second sentence, the
2 last sentence really indicates that more than three are
3 affected, and that would then require the referendum of
4 the State at large.

5 MR. MILLER: Wouldn't it also require the
6 consent of the other? That is the point I am trying to
7 clear up as to whether you have the consent.

8 MR. CLAGETT: That is not the intent of the
9 Committee.

10 MR. MILLER: I didn't think it was, so don't
11 you think you better change it?

12 MR. CLAGETT: If you refer back to the Fifth
13 Report, we had language there which did tend to clarify
14 it, and it read rather than of the voters residing within
15 the areas proposed to be transferred from one County to
16 another, and it was the thinking of the Commission at
17 that time that that was surplusage, and we were directed
18 to consider striking it out. Now, the thought is that
19 if there is any confusion, we could put those words back
20 in, and the sentence would then read, The lines of more
21 than three contiguous Counties but less than all the
