have been poring through some decisions on contiguous.

Don't rely on it. When you get into the word, contiguous, it is like Governor Lane's research on autonomous. It can be construed more than one way and you are just looking for a lawsuit, I am afraid. It doesn't necessarily always mean what you and I think contiguous means.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Della?

MR. CLAGETT: We had understood it to mean adjoining, that means touching, in proximity.

MR. MILLER: That is what I thought it meant, too, but there are cases that hold it to the general neighborhood.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Della?

MR. DELLA: Mr. Chairman, I have two questions, one is, as I read this, it appears to me that, say for instance, Prince Georges and Montgomery County, if they decided to become one County, just the voters of those two Counties could decide that they could dissolve their lines and become one County. Now, at the same time, it also raises a question.
