

1 MR. DELLA: Yes, the Anne Arundel County
2 delegation.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: It would have to be passed by
4 the Legislature, though, not just for those two Counties.

5 MR. DELLA: I recognize that, I recognize how
6 some of them operate, but I am using this as a supposi-
7 tion. If Baltimore City would want to take in Anne
8 Arundel County, which they wanted to do for a number of
9 years anyway, and they would get their legislation passed
10 and come to the voters for a decision, the voters in
11 Baltimore City are going to outweigh the voters in Anne
12 Arundel County by a vast majority.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: You are talking about taking
14 over the whole of Anne Arundel County?

15 MR. DELLA: There is nothing to prevent it.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: I know, but if it is anything
17 less than the whole of Anne Arundel County, then under
18 the second sentence Anne Arundel County voters could
19 veto it.

20 MR. CASE: It is only the voters who live in
21 the area to be transferred.
