THE CHAIRMAN: But it seems to me that you get into awkward situations. Suppose you had a bill that proposed that all of Baltimore County except the Fifth District should be added to Baltimore City, and the Fifth Election District of Baltimore County should be added to Carroll County.

MR. CLACETT: Then you have two entirely separate situations, and that district would have a choice.

THE CHAIRMAN: All was remaining a part of the County. But then contrast that with a situation, instead of doing that, the Legislature adds all of Baltimore County to Baltimore City, then none of Baltimore County has a choice.

MR. CLAGETT: The thinking of the Committee was to favor consolidation, but to discourage tempering.
