

1 except as to the permissiveness of the Legislature decid-
2 ing whether or not to submit it to referendum.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: So you don't need anything on
4 that?

5 MR. SAYRE: Unless we do have it, the Legis-
6 lature cannot now do it, can they?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Why not?

8 MR. SAYRE: Under the new proposed Constitu-
9 tion. The only Article we have is on petition.

10 THE CHAIRMAN. The Legislature can submit
11 a matter to referendum or pass a law. There certainly
12 isn't anything that says you can't in the existing
13 Consitution.

14 DR. WINSLOW: I thought there was a court
15 case on that that said they couldn't, a Legislature can-
16 not submit the matter to a referendum of the people of
17 the State.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: If there is, I am not familiar
19 with it. Certainly, unless I am very much wrong, there
20 have been bills that the Legislature has passed and sub-
21 mitted to referendum.
